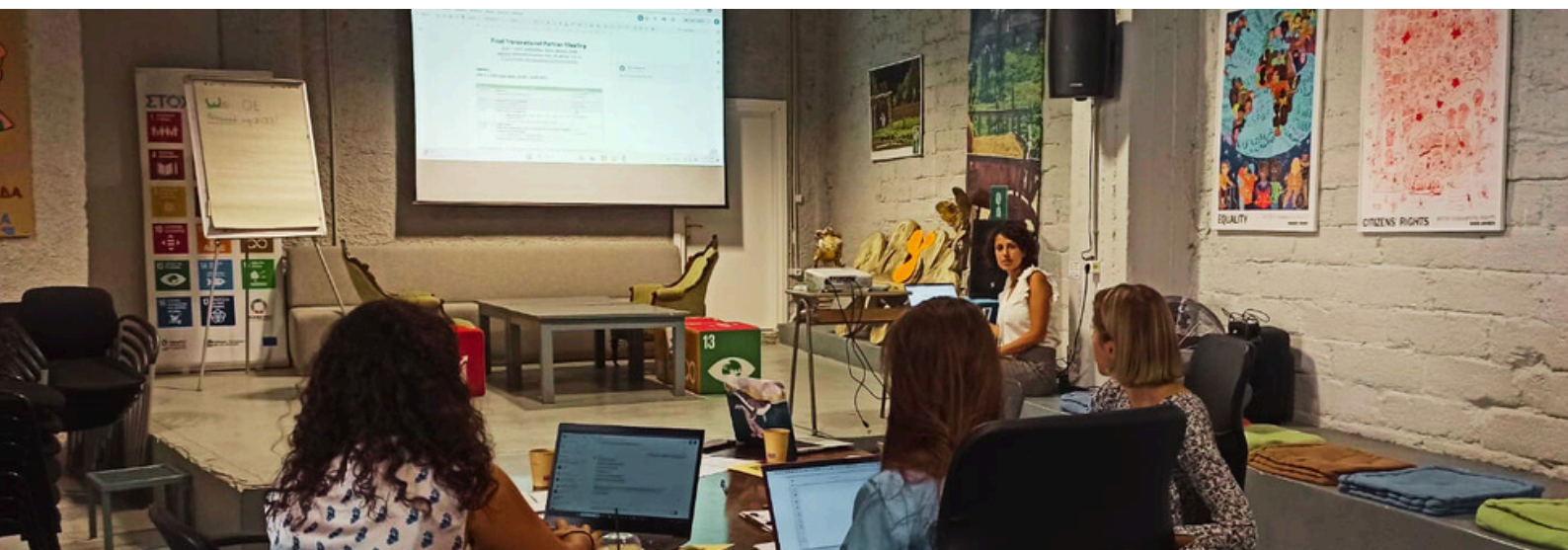
Educational Toolkit: A Framework for Social Innovation and Community Development
