Final Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) in Athens

The culmination of the BeYou project took place in Athens on September 12–13, 2024, at Organisation Earth, where all partners gathered to review the project's achievements. The TPM was an opportunity to reflect on the progress made, wrap up administrative tasks, and discuss the future. Partners from Greece, Italy, Spain, Romania, and Cyprus celebrated the successful implementation of 20 youth-led projects and finalized plans for continuing the project's legacy.

As part of the meeting, partners evaluated the social impact of the initiatives, which have empowered young people to become changemakers in their communities. The discussions emphasized the long-term sustainability of the project and explored potential collaborations for future endeavors.

Training and Learning Activity in Athens
